Information and Registration - 2013 GLSF-OZ Fishing Derby

I. 2013 DERBY DATES

Begin	Friday, July 5	4 a.m.
Continues	Saturday, July 6	
Ends	Sunday, July 7	5 p.m.

II. SPECIES

Five species of fish may be registered for the Derby: Chinook Salmon, Coho Salmon, Rainbow Trout, Lake Trout and Brown Trout.

III. BOUNDARY LIMITS

Derby boundary limits will be the Northern Sheboygan County Line to the Southern Milwaukee County Line. **NOTE:** No fishing is allowed in WEPCO's "cooling pond" by South breakwall.

IV. DERBY TICKETS

A. Prior to July 5th advance tickets cost \$25 per Individual or Family - 1st person ticket. Each additional Family - extra person ticket is \$10, either in advance or after July 4th. A Family - extra person is for either a spouse or child under the age of 18. Effective July 5th through the end of the contest Individual tickets or Family - 1st person tickets will be \$30. **Note: Each person will have their own ticket.**

B. Tickets must be purchased prior to fishing, and any tickets sold after the Derby has started will be marked by a GLSF-OZ attendant as to the time and date of purchase. No tickets will be sold after 1 pm on July 7.

C. Tickets must be signed by the contestant in the area indicated at the time of purchase.

D. Each individual angler in a boat is requested to have a ticket.
1. When fishing on paid charter boats, all fish entered must be caught by the contestant without any assistance other than handing the rod to the angler and netting the fish.
2. Charter Captains and members of their crew will not be eligible to register fish caught aboard a paid charter. Charter customers can register fish if eligible under Derby rules.

E. Entry tickets are available at the Port Marina Office (at the boat launch), Tri Par, Saukville, Bait Box, Port Washington, from GLSF-OZ members, or by mail from Don Clark, 624 Deer Pass Road, Saukville, WI 53080.

V. FISH REGISTRATION

A. Fish registration hours are:

Friday, July 5	9 am to 8 pm
Saturday, July 6	9 am to 8 pm
Sunday, July 7	9 am to 5 pm

B. All contestants in line at daily closing will be honored.

C. Entered fish must be caught on hook and line in accordance with the conservation laws of the State of Wisconsin.

D. Each contestant must hold a valid Wisconsin fishing license with salmon stamp (unless exempt from the law) and may be asked to present it at the fish registration area.

E. All fish caught by a contestant must be registered at Derby Headquarters on the same day and will be marked by a weigh-in attendant.

F. No frozen or discolored fish will be accepted for registration. Judges will have the right to determine the validity of weight by cutting the fish. At the discretion of the judges a lie detector (Polygraph) test may be required of any contestant eligible for a prize.

VI. FISH DISPLAY

A. The top two fish in each category will be placed on display during the Derby. Any fish out of a top spot will be removed from the display. Owner will be responsible for picking up fish before the end of the Derby. Unclaimed fish will be donated to charity.

VII. DERBY PRIZES

A. Derby contest prizes will be awarded by individual fish weight. In case of a tie, the greatest length will place higher. If both weight and length tie, earliest registration will place higher.

B. Prizes will be awarded for 10 places in each of 5 categories. If a contestant has a fish in one of the 10 places and registers a larger fish in that category, the larger fish will take precedence over the smaller fish.

C. Derby Grand Prize winner will be determined by a drawing from the five first place finishers at 6:00 pm on Sunday, July 7 or immediately after the last eligible fish is registered. The winner of the drawing will receive the Grand Prize, with the remaining 4 receiving first prizes. This drawing does not affect the standings of 2nd through 10th place prizes.

D. Derby prizes will be awarded after the Grand Prize. Winners not present at this time will be notified and must claim their prize before August 30, 2013 at The Village Printer, Inc. 408 Dekora, Saukville, WI Ph. (262) 284-9898 Any prizes not claimed by August 30 are forfeited.

VIII. OTHER PRIZES

A. A grab bag prize will be given for every 5th fish registered.

B. There will be a daily random drawing of ticket stubs for a large assortment of door prizes, with the winning stubs posted on the bulletin board at Derby Headquarters.

C. Prizes awarded in A and B above must be claimed by 8 pm on Sunday, July 7 or they will be forfeited.

IX. LARGEST FISH OF THE DAY

\$50 in cash will be given to the largest fish caught each day. This prize will be given each day.

X. LIABILITY EXCLUSION

Every reasonable precaution will be taken by the contest committee to protect property during the derby. However, GLSF-Ozaukee Chapter, its officers and members are not responsible for the safety or the property of participants from theft, or damage or injury by fire, accident, vandalism or other causes. All participants further understand and agree to release and hold harmless the aforementioned from any liability or claim for damages incurred as a result of participation in the derby in whatever form or manner said liabilities, damages or injuries might be incurred.

XI. MISTAKES OR OMISSIONS

Mistakes or omissions are possible and are not meant to change rules.
