



2013 Special Events that may impede access on Lincoln Memorial Drive (LMD)

Marina Slip tenants and Sailing Center members will be allowed access to Lagoon Drive during the following events with proper identification:

May 25-26 Family Kite Festival - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians.

June 2 UPAF Ride for the Arts - LMD northbound lanes will be closed from Michigan Street to Kenwood Boulevard between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. as well as the southbound lanes from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

June 15 Summerfest Rock 'N Sole Run - Northbound and southbound lanes of LMD will be closed from 4 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. from Michigan Street to Mason Street and from 6 AM until 10:30 AM from Mason Street to Lake Drive.

June 21-23 Lakefront Festival of the Arts - This event has moved from Veterans Park to the west side of the Art Museum. Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians. A parking operation will be run in Veterans Park, so traffic on Lagoon Drive could be very heavy at times. All access points will remain open.

June 21 & 22 Malibu Open Pro-ski Show at Juneau Lagoon - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians. A parking operation will be run in Veterans Park, McKinley Park & the Gun Club site. All access points will remain open.

June 26 Summerfest's Big Bang - Because the fireworks are so popular and draw such a large crowd, the Parks Department will run a grass parking operation off of Lagoon Drive beginning at about 3:30 p.m. Slip tenant access to center and south sections of the Marina will be allowed with proper identification.

July 3 US Bank Fireworks As in years past, LMD will close in the mid- to late-afternoon. Try to get to the lakefront early. Slip tenants and Sailing Center members with JULY 3RD PARKING PASSES will be allowed access from Lafayette Hill Road after LMD closes. Each slip tenant will be responsible for picking up parking passes at the marina office.

July 21 NML Roots and Wings Run - Northbound and southbound lanes of LMD will be closed from Michigan Street to Lagoon Drive between 8:00 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.

August 3-4 Milwaukee Water & Air Show - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians. A parking operation will be run in Veterans Park. All access points will remain open.

August 10-11 USA Triathlon - Northbound and southbound lanes of LMD will be closed from 7 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, and until 12:00 pm on Sunday, from Michigan Street Kenwood Blvd.



August 24-25 Masterpiece Car Show - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians. A parking operation will be run at Veterans Park. All access points will remain open.

August 29 - September 1 Harley Davidson 110 Anniversary - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians. All access points will remain open.

September 7-8 Frank Mott's Int'l. Kite Festival - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians.

September 14 Children's Hospital Run - Northbound and southbound lanes of LMD will be closed from Michigan Street to Lafayette Hill Road between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

September 14 Rock the Green Festival - Expect congestion on LMD from cars as well as pedestrians. A parking operation will be run in Veterans Park.

September 22 Komen Milwaukee Race for the Cure - Northbound and southbound lanes of LMD will be closed from Michigan Street to Lafayette Hill Road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Access to LMD from the north will be available at all times. Lagoon Drive will be closed from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

October 6 Milwaukee Lakefront Marathon - Limited access on Lagoon Drive from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to the South and Center Marina tenants. Limited access means that you may have to wait until runners have passed an intersection before gaining access to the Marina.
